CEU's Available

Continuing Education Units are available for most trainings. Anyone needing to renew their CDA can now receive their CEU's for an additional \$15.00 charge per person per class. CDA renewal requires 4.5 CEU's, which is the equivalent to 45 clock hours of training over 3 years. CEU's must be requested and paid for at the time of registration. Unfortunately CEU's cannot be back dated.

Certificate Replacement Fee

There is a \$10.00 fee for replacing lost training certificates. Training records are kept for a period of 5 years. Payment must be received prior to processing a replacement certificate.

Cancellations/Credit

Cancellations must be made at least 48 hours prior to the class start date to receive credit. Credit will not be given to the facility for a 'no-show' participant. All credits must be used in the fiscal year they were credited.
